

LANDSCAPE COMMITTEE MINUTES

November 10, 2015

Meeting called to order at 1 PM. Minutes from October meeting were reviewed and approved.

Advised Yellowstone will be replacing warranty plants in the median and deadheading on Friday.

We reviewed the contract with Rizzetta for landscape services and the scope of contract for the circle. Several suggestions such as keeping palm where it is, exacting what facing for walls, use of existing crotons, use of succulents, is Benderson look too different to other landscaping in Waterlefe. We will extend an invitation to Mr. Toburg to attend our next Landscape Committee.

We are going with White Diamond for planting of geraniums. We are scheduled for first part of December. Because of heat and no rain, our current beds have matured faster than expected. No earlier date available at White Diamond. ☹ We discussed how to have them plant the pink and red geraniums. Judy Jones is the liaison to work with White Diamond.

We also discussed spring flowers. Tyree suggest Blue Daze and white Alyssum; White Diamond vinca and Penta. We will be adding Crossandra a perennial at this planting. Phyllis also had a suggestion and will check for exact name. More discussion next meeting.

UMRR Lighting will be fixed Thursday.

The grasses will be removed from guard house and a ground cover, Peanut will be planted.

We thought our roses should be deadheaded and check when last fertilized.

A concern of the dead frond on palm trees in the cul de sacs and overgrown phillies. I advised this trimming was scheduled by Yellowstone to be done in November.

We felt the mulch should concentrate on Waterlefe Blvd. rather than UMRR.

I will advise Rita of more dead Washingtonians long Winding Stream.

Judy Jones is continuing to see if any grants available.
