

## LANDSCAPE COMMITTEE MINUTES

16 November 2016

Present at the meeting were: R Kurtis, T King, R Carroll, J Crawford, J Fowler, J Brocki.

New Committee members were welcomed.

The Committee reviewed the status of ongoing landscape updates for areas in the community including: cul-de-sac circles, and the golf course parking lot. The plan for the replacement of the flowers at the end caps was also reviewed.

The Committee reviewed the plan for the update of the landscape at the main traffic circle in Waterlefe, as submitted by Simply Verde. The Committee supported the plan in general and suggested the addition of decorative stone walls to support and accentuate the ground slope at the circle. The Committee also reviewed an additional plan to install a fountain at the circle. The concept of a fountain received support, although the cost might be prohibitive.

The Committee discussed the poor condition of the knock out roses at the entrance to Waterlefe. Although the plants had been recently treated and fertilized, they are not responding well. The Committee recommended cutting back the plants to see if they can be revived. The Committee will review possible replacement plants if the roses do not respond.

The Committee discussed the deterioration of the juniper and hawthorn plants in the islands along Waterlefe Boulevard. Committee members will review this problem and recommend replacement plants.

The Committee discussed the vines currently growing in front of the monuments at the entrance to Waterlefe. Committee members will consider possible replacements for the vines to include decorative stones.

Committee members were asked to review the Landscape Committee web site and recommend improvements.
