

EROSION COMMITTEE MINUTES
MAY 20, 2014

The meeting was called to order at 1PM. A motion to accept the April 15, 2014 was made by Roz Warner and seconded by Ron Myers. The motion was approved.

Our committee has got approval forms from 24 of the 33 residents who live on the pond where erosion work is being done this year. This form gives approval to walk on their property although the CDD has easements through out the area.

Update was given on this years work. The company doing the work is Bio Mass . They did the first year's work on Maritime. They started this years work on April 28 and expect to be finished July 1st. The original plan was to reclaim fill from the pond and put along the shoreline. They could not do this since the bottom of the pond was full of clay and shells. They have been trucking fill in and so far have used 80 truckloads. They will need another 70 truckloads to complete that part of the job. After this, they will add filter cloth followed by geo web, small stone and then sod. They will obtain a smoother 4 to 1 slope and will have gained 5 feet to the shoreline. All sod and drainage pipes will be fully restored.

Roz mentioned that Lake Masters have planted over 4000 plants along previously identified eroded shorelines. Lake Masters and Roz will evaluate the Portside/ Foggy Pond littoral shelf after the project is complete.

The Schar project is complete and looks great.
